

# NY State Immunization Requirements for School Entrance/Attendance 2014-15

## Pre-K

DtaP	4
Polio	3
MMR	1
Hep B	3
Hib	1-4 if less than 15 months 1 if 15 months or older
Varicella	1
PCV	1-4 if less than 15 months 1 if 15 months or older

## School (K-12)

DtaP	4-5 (if fourth dose given at age 4, fifth dose not required)
Tdap	1 (entering 6 <sup>th</sup> grade or at age 11)
Polio	3-4
MMR	1 if < 7 years old and 2 doses at age 7 (if received separately, only 2 doses <u>measles</u> and <u>mumps</u> required not rubella)
Hep B	3
Hib	NA
Varicella	2 when entering K or 6 <sup>th</sup> grade (new 2014-15)
PCV	NA

**Comvax** – Hep B + HIB

**Dtap** – Tetanus Toxoid-Containing Vaccine with Pertussis – also seen as **DTP**

**Daptacel** – DtaP

**Hep B** – Hepatitis B – series of 3

**Hib** – Haemophilus influenzae type b

**Kinrix** – Dtap + IVP

**MMR** – Measles, Mumps, and Rubella

**PCV** – Pneumococcal Conjugate Vaccine

**Pediarix** – combination of Dtap, IVP + Hep B

**Pentacel** – combination of DTap, IVP + Hib

**Polio** – **IPV** or **OPV**

**ProQuad** – Combination of MMR + Varicella

**Tdap** – Adult Tetanus Toxoid-Containing Vaccine with Pertussis – **Adacel** (given age 11-65) or **Boostrix** (age 10 to 18)

**Varicella** – Chickenpox or Varivax – can accept MD written statement proving history of disease or blood work showing immunity

**MCV** – Menactra – Meningococcal conjugate – offered around age 11

**HPV** – Gardasil – series of 3 offered to girls around age 11

**Havrix - Hepatitis A** – series of 2

**RotaTeq** – series of 3 given to prevent Rotavirus
